It is observed annually on the first Friday of June, was started in 1938 by the Salvation Army to help raise funds for those in need.

Though many countries have independently developed their own version of donuts (or doughnuts), the Dutch are widely credited with bringing the fried pastry to America prior to the Revolutionary War, originally calling them *olykoeks*, meaning "oily cakes."
