Switch Off to Light Up

Started by WWF and partners as a symbolic lights-out event in Sydney in 2007, Earth Hour is now one of the world's largest grassroots movements for the environment.

Held every year on the last Saturday of March, Earth Hour engages millions of people in more than 180 countries and territories, switching off their lights to show support for our planet. It has since become a catalyst for positive environmental impact, driving major legislative changes by harnessing the power of the people and collective action.

Since 2008 the WTC Complex has been participating in the Earth Hour project and this Saturday is no different. From 8.30pm to 9.30pm, we will switch off most of common areas lighting in the complex, but rest assured that power in tenants areas and emergency power system will not be affected. For tenants who have a signboard programmed with a 'sun-timer', we request your participation by turning the board off.
