Starting Fresh

We start 2023 by inching toward an endemic phase of Covid-19 after the government lifted all of the remaining public activity restrictions (PPKM) just before the turn of the year.

A ministerial instruction still contains provisions requiring regional administrations to take "proactive" and "persuasive" measures to prevent a surge in caseload.

To this end, local administrations are instructed to advise, not mandate, the public to keep wearing masks, particularly on public transportation, in crowds and when ill. They must also encourage people to get vaccinated, either with the primary series (doses one and two) or a booster dose (dose three), and to get tested if unwell.

At the WTC Complex, we encourage you to always put your mask on especially when indoors, continue to scan PeduliLindungi upon entering and remind you to stay vigilant, practice good personal hygiene and follow the health protocols.
