On Valentine's, Indonesians will cast their votes to elect the President, Vice President, People's Consultative Assembly (MPR, consisting of DPR and DPD) and members of local legislative bodies. The newly elected members of the MPR will be sworn in on October 1st 2024, while the President and Vice President are on the 20th.

All three presidential candidates will attend the final debate this Sunday before resuming their campaigns until February 10th and go into a 'quiet period' from the 11th to 13th where all ads, billboards, banners, flags etc will be taken down.
