BIGGEST HOUR FOR EARTH

Held every year on the last Saturday of March, Earth Hour engages millions of people in more than 190 countries and territories. It started as a lights out event in Sydney in 2007 and has since become a catalyst for positive environmental impact, driving major legislative changes by harnessing the power of the people and collective action.

With temperature threading dangerously close to breaching the 1.5°C global increase limit by 2030 -set by the Paris Climate Agreement- the Biggest Hour for Earth was launched last year and already has over 410,000 hours pledged on the 'Hour Bank'.

As an active supporter since 2009, Jakarta Land will continue to take part by switching off non-essential lighting in the WTC complex from 8.30pm to 9.30pm.
