Football fever is currently keeping the whole nation on edge as the country continues its fight to secure a place in the 2024 Paris Olympics.

Following a 2-0 semifinal defeat in the hands of Uzbekistan on Monday, the U-23 team must win against Iraq this Thursday for automatic qualification. Failure to do so will result in an Asian-African playoff against Guinea for the fourth and final ticket.

The U-23 Asian Cup is the Asian Football Confederation's qualification tournament for the Olympics, where football is played by mostly U-23 squads with three exceptions for older players allowed in each team.

Should Indonesia progress, it would be the first time back in the Olympics in nearly seven decades, with the last one being the 1956 Games in Melbourne.

The battle for third place will take place on May 2 at 22.30 Western Indonesia Time (WIB) at Abdullah bin Khalifa Stadium, Doha.
