A recently passed law governing the rights of women and children during the first 1,000 days of a child's life paves the way for longer maternity leave.

The law stipulates that a female worker is eligible for three months of maternity leave at the shortest, and can be prolonged for another three months in certain medical conditions, as proven by a statement from a doctor.
