17-AN AT WTC!

August is here and we know what that means: 17an!

79 years ago on August 17th, 1945, a proclamation of Indonesian Independence was read at 10 AM in Jakarta by Soekarno who later signed it alongside Mohammad Hatta on behalf of the people of Indonesia. Following the declaration, the red-and-white flag was hoisted and the national anthem, Indonesia Raya, was sung.

To celebrate the anniversary, starting in the 1950s, games such as *tarik tambang* (tug-of-war), *balap karung* (sack race), *makan kerupuk* (cracker eating) and *panjat pinang* (slippery pole climb) were played throughout the country.

Today, these games have become a tradition. They are fun, simple and promote teamwork and togetherness.
