Children in Pandemic

A new UNICEF report, *Towards a child-focused COVID-19 response and recovery: A Call to Action*, finds that 80 million children and adolescents in Indonesia are facing a widespread secondary impact on their learning, health, nutrition and economic security, more than a year into the pandemic.

It disrupts the education of millions of students, limits access to critical health, nutrition and protection services, daily routines and causes families to struggle to stay afloat financially. Existing inequalities have been exacerbated, which will have significant consequences on childhood development outcomes.

Nearly half of all households have also reported child behavioural challenges, with children finding it hard to concentrate (45%), becoming angrier (13%) and difficulty to sleep (6.5%)
